## **KAZUKO MIYAMOTO**

The Alessandra Bonomo Gallery will be inaugurating a solo exhibition by **Kazuko Miyamoto**, for the first time in Rome. Installations, paintings and drawings on paper will be on display. Miyamoto's creations explore, through their poetry and delicacy, different materials - such as industrial and natural elements - creating a very particular universe that blends Japanese culture and aesthetics, together with minimalism and the most interesting female artistic and crafts techniques.

**Kazuko Miyamoto** was born in Japan and moved to New York in 1964, where she presently lives and works. She met the artist Sol LeWitt in 1969 and was his assistant for long time. Kazuko Miyamoto is a member of A.I.R. (Artists in Residence), the first cooperative for women artists in the United States, from 1972. As of 1986 she has been directing the OneTwentyEight Gallery in New York City – an open space for young and interesting international artists. Her works of art are part of important private and public collections in Europe, as well as in the MoMA in New York and the National Museum of Modern Art in Kyoto. Kazuko Miyamoto received the Francis J. Greenburger Foundation Award in 2003 and the National Endowment for the Arts in 1980.
